Tan-Tar-A Resort offers 2 summer programs so there's something for everyone!

Summer Work Experience: Up to 12 weeks of experience in one main department (from the list below). Full time hours, competitive pay and the option to assist other departments whenever you are not scheduled, if you want extra experience and income. Affordable housing available within 1 mile of the resort. This program is open to anyone seeking industry experience. This program is not a formal internship, but can meet the requirements of most internship classes.

Management Internship: From 10 to 26 weeks of experience in one main department or area of the resort. Full time hours, competitive pay and a variety of supervisory experiences to build on your existing knowledge and skill base. Affordable housing available on the resort. **This program is open only to Hospitality students who have previously worked at Tan-Tar-A** (as interns or previous summer workers) and is designed to meet the requirements of an internship class.

- Be sure to answer all questions fully and honestly. Background checks are carried out for all new hires. Past convictions (felony/ misdemeanor/ local ordinance) will not disqualify you from a position, but must be disclosed prior to receipt of the background check.
- Summer Work Experience positions are open to anyone but preference will be given to students currently enrolled in a hospitality-related field of study (proof of enrollment required)
- Management Internship positions are open only to Hospitality students with previous experience at Tan-Tar-A Resort.
- Limited dormitory-style accommodation is available to students only (proof of enrollment required). Transportation to and from work is not provided. Interns are housed separately from those on the Summer Work Experience program.



OPPORTUNITIES

Banquets & Catering

Gain a wide variety of experiences in multiple banquet and event settings either working with the Catering team to prepare event rooms for meetings, food service and group functions or with the Banquets team to provide seamless and efficient food service during functions. Ability to work quickly but with strong attention to detail is necessary to ensure continuous customer satisfaction. Strong customer service and excellent hospitality skills are essential. A great foundation for a career in Event Planning.

Beverage

May work as Bartender or Banquet Bartender if age 21 or over, and can demonstrate previous bartending experience. Lounge server position available if age 18 or over, no previous experience necessary. Learn the ropes in a variety of settings within the resort, indoors and out. Customer service and assertive hospitality skills required for all beverage positions.

Restaurants

Opportunity to build and develop service skills in either the casual or fine dining restaurant at the resort as Dining Room Assistant, Server or Host/ Hostess (depending on experience and skills). Hospitality skills and neat appearance is essential. Ability to handle a busy work environment without compromising customer service is essential. A great introduction to the food and beverage industry in a busy setting.

Housekeeping

The best place to begin a career in hotel and lodging is right here, in the “belly” of the resort where you will learn what goes into making every guest’s stay comfortable and memorable. Must be 18 years of age or older to work as Room Attendant or Laundry Worker. These are very physically demanding jobs that require the ability to lift up to 40 pounds and work on feet in a fast-paced, detail oriented position. Involves a lot of stair climbing and working outside in all types of weather. Room Attendants have direct contact with guests so a customer service focus is essential.

Front Desk

Develop strong customer service and organizational skills working on Front Desk or in PBX (Operator). Must be able to confidently extend a warm and efficient welcome to our guests every time. Assertive hospitality, good communication, typing and cash handling skills are essential. The environment on Front Desk is fast-paced with a strong attention to detail and a willingness to do what it takes to provide every guest with a seamless check in/ check out experience. Professional appearance and ability to remain calm are also essential.

Recreation

Work indoors out outdoors to provide our guests with safe and fun recreational activities at the Marina (Attendant or Cashier), Fitness Center, Pool Attendant (indoor, outdoor or water park). Cashiering experience, knowledge of the lake, ability to pump gas, lifeguarding/ lifesaving and/ or CPR qualifications are helpful dependant on the position. Good communication and hospitality skills are required.

Culinary

Opportunities abound to build on your existing culinary skills in the banquet kitchen or one of two restaurants on the property (casual or fine dining). Must have some previous culinary experience and a willingness to learn in a fast-paced environment.

Seasonal positions may also be available in the Food Court, the Groundskeeping team and Gift Shops.

All positions require you to be able to work a flexible schedule with days off being scheduled according to guest demand.
